



Ketosis Treatment Fortified with NIACINAMIDE, CHOLINE CHLORIDE, AND METHIONINE for Dairy and Beef Cattle

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Dairy and Beef Cattle

Give one tube when ketosis symptoms are evident. Hold animal's head in a slightly elevated position and place tube in mouth directly over the tongue. Quickly express the correct amount into the animal's mouth and hold closed until product is swallowed. Do not use rope or restraint that will choke animal. Can be given once daily for 3 - 5 days.

Animal must have swallowing reflex to avoid aspiration. Use extreme care to prevent injury to the animal's mouth and throat tissue when dispensing Radix Labs Fortified Ketosis Gel. Do not allow the animal to chew on the tip of the tube, which can result in mouth laceration. Do not dispense to animals with open sores in the mouth or throat. Gel may cause irritation to eyes and skin.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Dairy and Beef Cattle

Give one tube when milk fever symptoms are evident. Hold animal's head in a slightly elevated position and place tube in mouth directly over the tongue. Quickly express the correct amount into the animal's mouth and hold closed until product is swallowed. Do not use rope or restraint that will choke animal. Can be given once or twice daily for 2 days before calving and after calving.

PRECAUTIONS:

Animal must have swallowing reflex to avoid aspiration. Use extreme care to prevent injury to the animal's mouth and throat tissue when dispensing Radix Labs Fortified Milk Fever Gel. Do not allow the animal to chew on the tip of the tube, which can result in mouth laceration. Do not dispense to animals with open sores in the mouth or throat. Gel may cause irritation to eves and skin.
